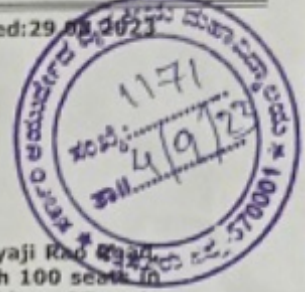

**Subject:-** Grant of Conditional Permission to Govt. Ayurveda Medical College & Hospital, Sayyaji Rao Road, Vishweshwaraiah Circle, Distt. Mysore-570021, Karnataka (Inst. Id- AYU0046) with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 22 Seats in 04 PG courses in the subjects namely (i) Kayachikitsa- 07 seats (ii) Swasthavritta - 05 Seats (iii) Panchkarma- 05 seats (iv) Ayurved Samhita, Sanskrit & Siddhanta- 05 seats, for the academic session 2023-24 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder-reg.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

1. It is pertinent to mention that the Conditional permission with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 22 Seats in 04 PG courses in the subjects namely (i) Kayachikitsa- 07 seats (ii) Swasthavritta - 05 Seats (iii) Panchkarma- 05 seats (iv) Ayurved Samhita, Sanskrit & Siddhanta- 05 seats for the academic session 2022-23 was issued to you on the basis of the affidavit submitted by the Commissioner, Department of Ayush; Govt. of Karnataka, vide letter no. AYUSH/11/ME(2)/2021-22 on 09.11.2022, during the first appeal filed by you to the Commission in respect of issuance of Conditional permission for the Academic Year 2022-23.
2. Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely Govt. Ayurveda Medical College & Hospital, Sayyaji Rao Road, Vishweshwaraiah Circle, Distt. Mysore-570021, Karnataka (Inst. Id- AYU0046) inspection of your College was conducted on 15.05.2023 & 16.05.2023 on hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the conditional permission for 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 22 Seats in 04 PG courses in the subjects namely (i) Kayachikitsa- 07 seats (ii) Swasthavritta - 05 Seats (iii) Panchkarma- 05 seats (iv) Ayurved Samhita, Sanskrit & Siddhanta- 05 seats for the academic session 2023-24 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.
3. Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", "The Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under.
4. As per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the assessment report was placed in the 43<sup>rd</sup> Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 15.06.2023. On careful examination of the assessment report it was found that Animal House is not present in your college which is mandatory as per PG Regulation 2016. Hence, Board decided to ask the clarification regarding the aforementioned shortcoming found during the assessment and same was communicated to you vide letter of even no. dated 23.08.2023. In response on the same you have submitted the clarification vide an email dated 28.08.2023 enclosing a letter vide ref. no. GAMC/02/NCISM/2022-23 dated 28.08.2023. After analyzing the clarification it has been decided to issue the Conditional permission with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 22 Seats in 04 PG courses in the subjects namely (i) Kayachikitsa- 07 seats (ii) Swasthavritta - 05 Seats (iii)



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Panchkarma- 05 seats (iv) Ayurved Samhita, Sanskrit & Siddhanta- 05 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24.

5. Therefore, Conditional Permission is granted to Govt. Ayurveda Medical College & Hospital, Sayyaji Rao Road, Vishweshwaraiah Circle, Distt. Mysore-570021, Karnataka (Inst. Id- AYU0046) with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 22 Seats in 04 PG courses in the subjects namely (i) Kayachikitsa- 07 seats (ii) Swasthavritta - 05 Seats (iii) Panchkarma- 05 seats (iv) Ayurved Samhita, Sanskrit & Siddhanta- 05 seats, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24 subject to the condition that college is fulfilling the following requirements: -
1. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 100 UG seats and 04 PG courses with 22 seats shall be treated as All India Quota. The counseling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2023-24 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for All India Quota or the students admitted thereunder.
6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
7. Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular or the subsequent academic year.
8. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
9. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2023 and send a compliance report to get permission for the academic session 2024-25: -
- i) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
- ii) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda).
- iii) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto, and
- iv) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 for grant of permission to PG Courses.
10. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2024-25.
